

5th Grade Syllabus

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Welcome to fifth grade! We have very high expectations for our classrooms to ensure the best education possible for our students. The following is a list of expectations/rules and consequences that your child will be expected to follow at all times. Please read everything carefully and discuss the importance of these items with your child. We will be reviewing these expectations the first few weeks of school in class too.

Communication

First and foremost, communication is very important to your child's learning. We believe that learning is a partnership between parents and teachers. On the first day of school we will, as a class, discuss what each rule means and how we are expected to follow them. For the most part, consequences will be as stated below; however every student and situation is different, so when some situations arise the consequence will need to fit the unique situation. When your child breaks a rule, he/she will sign the behavior contract binder. You will be notified by a letter stating what rule he/she broke and what consequence he/she received.

General Consequences

- **First Offense:** Verbal Warning
- **Second Offense:** 10 minute loss of recess
- **Third Offense:** lunch detention
- **Fourth Offense:** parent/teacher conference
- **Fifth Offense:** office referral

Grading Scale

In Class Assignments

Students will be expected to complete individual assignments during class. They will be given ample time to complete these assignments. Any student who does not complete an assignment during the time given will be kept in at recess until the assignment is completed. If the assignment was given after recess that day and is not completed in the time given, it will be placed on the student's desk the next morning to be completed AFTER their morning work for that day. If it is not completed at this time they will miss their recess to finish it. I DO NOT send unfinished work home to be completed unless it is due to an absence.

Projects

Students will complete a reading fair and science fair project this year. More details to come for each project.

AR Expectations

This year expectations for AR are pretty much the same as in past years. Each quarter students will have a point goal, a percent correct goal, and a reading level goal. This expectation helps students to read not only for points, but also to work on their comprehension of stories and making sure they are reading books that are "just right" for them.

Additional Information:

This year, students will take some familiar assessments, such as STAR reading and math and NWEA MAP testing. In addition to these assessments, your child will have to take state tests. Please review all reports that are sent home. These are indicators to see if your child is where he/she should be academically.
