- Not Allowed: JEANS

Tuesday-Drugs are old school!

- Allowed: wigs, canes, suspenders, curlers, glasses, shawls, scarves, flannel shirts, bowties
- Not Allowed: JEANS

Wednesday-Too Smart to Start!

- Allowed: taped glasses, suspenders, high-waisted shorts, knee-high socks, button-down shirts
- Not Allowed: JEANS

Thursday-Peace Out to Drugs!

- Allowed: scarves, boots, peace sign jewelry, disco-type clothing, sunglasses
- Not Allowed: WIGS, JEANS

- Allowed: Capes, hats/mask (must coordinate with outfit), boots, Super Hero shirts/socks
- Not Allowed: Jeans, full body suits
